Core scores include averages from Reading, Language, and Math. The Composite scores are the Core scores plus Science, Social Studies, and Sources of Information.

The grade equivalent is a number that describes a student's location on an achievement continuum. Grade equivalency is expressed in terms of grade and months into grade, assuming a 10-month school year (e.g., 8.4 means after four months of instruction in 8th grade). Example: Our 8th grade class grade equivalency this year is the fifth month of grade twelve.

Stanine is a derivation of the term "standard-nine" scale. Stanines are normalized standard scores, ranging in value from 1-9, whose distribution has a mean of 5 and a standard deviation of 2. A stanine of 5 is about average, a 6 stanine is somewhat above average, and a 7 stanine is above average.
